Parking Rules

- **Driving to school is a privilege, not a right.**
- To park at SWHS, you must show proof of valid license, registration, and insurance.
- Parking is done by first come, first serve basis.
- The only student parking area is the rear of the school next to football stadium. All other parking lots around the school are off-limits to students.
- Parking in an off-limits area or parking without a current parking pass will result in the following actions: 1st offense will be a written warning. 2nd offense is a 2 week (10 days) suspension of parking privileges. 3rd offense will be a 1 month suspension of parking privileges. 4th and final offense will result in the student losing the ability to park at SWHS for the remainder of the school year.
- Once a student arrives on school grounds, he or she will lock their vehicle, enter the school building and is not allowed to leave school before the end of the school day unless they are checked out in the front office.
- No students will be allowed to go to their vehicle during the school days without a pass from the front office.
- Speeding and reckless driving will not be tolerated.
- All vehicles are subject to search upon reasonable suspicion.
