1. THEME - "Top Secret! Your mission is to fly aircraft in the world."

For over a century, human beings have perceived themselves in flight. In the twentieth century, it was remarkable to see the development of powered air machinery.

Think about flying in the world. Imagine, for example, that your mission as the top secret is to fly a Lockheed SR -71 strategic reconnaissance aircraft in the Spanish Land to photograph in the other parts of the world. Jeffrey Scott Davey, a gifted second grader, knew the fact that the SR-71 Blackbird spy-plane could cruise at more than Mach 3 (three times the speed of sound) at a height of 80,000 ft or more. The Blackbird's cameras, radars and infra-red sensors can map 60,000 square miles in an hour. If you fly this SR-71 aircraft, you will find how advanced is the equipment in use by listening the radio and radar signals. In his dream, Jeffrey saw unidentified flying objects, and kept the information as top secret because it was a threat to national security.

The theme for the 2018 aviation art contest is "Top Secret!" In this Contest, can you imagine yourself or someone whose mission is to fly aircraft in the world? What is your top secret?

2. FORMAT:

The required format is A3 (11.75" x 16.50"). Or the nearest possible equivalent if this required format is not able to obtain; however, the artwork with the format of 8.5"x11" will not be accepted. Artwork must not be frames or outlines with borders.

3. MEDIUM:

All artwork must be original and unassisted work and original idea, and must be completed by hand. Any of the following media are permitted: watercolor, acrylic, oil paint, indelible marker pens, felt-tip pens, soft ball-point pens, indelible ink, crayon, color pencils, or any similar indelible medium.

4. MARKINGS:

The following information should be clearly shown on the back of the artwork and creative arts: title (related to the theme), family name, given name, date of birth (Month/Day/Year), address (home), name and address of school which the child attends, and certificate of authenticity (See page 2).

5. ELIGIBILITY & AGE GROUP:

Students in grades 1 through 12 in the U.S. in the age group shown below may participate in the contest:

Group 1: Junior Category. Ages 7 to 10.

Group 2: Intermediate Category. Ages 11 to 14.

Group 3: Senior Category. Ages 15 to 18.

6. AWARDS: ALL ENTRANTS WILL RECEIVE A PRIZE OR GIFT.

1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners receive an award certificate and a prize. In addition, Multiple Grand Prize Winners may be selected from the entire entries. The Multiple Grand Prizes may include two round-trip airplane tickets (non-transferable and non-refundable tickets with no changes to the itinerary) within the same State (where a grand prize winner resides) in the U.S. (Some restrictions apply) and two one-time scholarships of \$1,500 for H.S. Seniors and Award of \$1,000 for 2012-14 JSD Art Award Winners.

7. REPRODUCTION RIGHTS: Once received, entries remain the property of the Sueno Yoshida Foundation and may be used for a variety of purposes.

8. REQUIREMENTS & DEADLINE:

An original artwork and/or creative art including markings on the back of the artwork, and this Entry Form (and the 2018 Sueno Yoshida Foundation Scholarship Application for graduating high school senior students who wish to receive a \$1,500 or \$1,000 scholarship for college) must be complete in one packet for it to be considered for the art contest. Entries must be postmarked by February 28, 2018 to: Sueno Yoshida Foundation, Attn: Jeffrey Scott Davey Aviation Art Contest, P. O. Box 15404, Panama City, Florida 32406. Notification of Receipt - If you wish confirmation of the receipt of your entrance, your parent must provide an e-mail address where your parent can be notified and request notification. Prize winners will be notified by phone, e-mail, or mail on or about 4/29/2018. Entrants must be students in grades 1 through 12, the U.S. citizens, and must reside in the U. S.
